Data Privacy Policy



Personal Information

The WPCA holds the personal information of its members in order to:

- communicate with them in both paper form and electronically
- enable them to communicate with each other

The personal information consists of:

- name
- street address
- email address
- telephone number(s)
- boat details
- images & videos
- subscription details

The WPCA uses the personal information of its current members

- to communicate with them both electronically and in paper form
- to create membership lists circulated to members, and available on its website. These lists do not include full street address or email address
- to promote its activities on the internet, and in the press and media (names, images and videos only)

The WPCA stores the personal information on:

- electronic storage devices
- an overseas email service

The WPCA erases all of a member's personal information when their subscription has not been renewed for five years.

Security

Members' personal information is held on encrypted (password protected) electronic storage devices held at multiple locations in the UK.

The overseas email service (currently MailChimp) is password protected and is certified with EU-U.S. Privacy Shield Framework and the Swiss-U.S. Privacy Shield Framework.
